GENERAL INFORMATION



In the course of the period of September-December 2013, CNC member organizations in the Chechen Republic, the Republic of Ingushetia and in Northern Ossetia-Alania implemented the advocacy action plan to promote the idea of inclusion in North Caucasus. The main strategic directions of the plan are: visualization of the inclusive education topic, direct assistance, and raising profile of the CNC in the region of North Caucasus.

PROMOTION OF THE CNC



Workshop – «CNC – experience and future prospects»



The following events had as one of their goals raising the profile of the CNC:

- workshop «CNC – experience and future prospects» - October 2013
- Presentation of the CNC activities at the interregional meetings of the North Caucasus NGOs – October and November 2013



Round table – “Inclusive Education in the North Caucasus – real steps»



Participants of the round tables – representatives of the governmental structures, Chechen Ministry of Education and Science educators, NGO staff, as well as colleagues from Dagestan and Ingushetia.



Teacher ethics training – the code of ethics for work with children with special needs, September – October 2013.

20 educators, social workers have received training aiming at preventing the risk of drop out for children with special education needs during the process of their adaptation in school – develop skills of communication with SEN children.



Training for 20 educators, social workers and school psychologists on the methodology of the Fairytale therapy as an effective tool of the ART-therapy for work with children in school.



CHILDREN WRITE FAIRYTALES – WORK IN SMALL GROUPS

(6 groups conducted, 30 tales for children and adults collected)

Objective – create atmosphere of trust, transformation of the traumatic experiences, help participants overcome the zone of discomfort and present their inner world to the outsiders



By December 3, 2013, the International Day of Persons with Disabilities, the group of young volunteers had prepared a video reel and placed it on the Facebook, and also demonstrated as a flash mob action in two café in Grozny

Advocacy actions to be completed by the end of December:

- **a brochure with the fairytales written by children (100 copies)**
 - **dissemination of flyers on the CNC activities in Northern Caucasus region of Russian Federation - (100 copies)**
 - **completion of the action "From door to door" – visiting children with special needs with New Year greetings (presents)**
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
